Impaired driving charge laid after officer on patrol spots erratic driver

Halton Regional Police charged a Mississauga man with impaired driving after a vehicle was spotted being operated erratically Sunday morning in Halton Hills.

According to a Halton Police report, an officer on patrol observed a black Ford Taurus traveling westbound on 10 Sideroad at around 2:45 a.m. weaving from side to side on the roadway. Police reported the vehicle came to a stop at a red light briefly, then proceeded to drive through the intersection, accelerating at a high rate of speed.

A traffic stop was initiated by the officer and the accused was found to be driving under suspension as well as having unpaid fines.

Charged with impaired driving and having over 80mg of



alcohol in 100ml of blood, along with the Highway Traffic Act charges of driving while suspended and failing to stop at a red light, is Jeffrey Woods, 31.

A 55-year-old passenger in the vehicle from Toronto was also arrested on an outstanding warrant.

A Milton woman is facing an impaired driving charge following a head-on collision Saturday morning with a tractor trailer.

The driver of a silver Audi sedan suffered minor injuries and was taken to Milton District Hospital, while the vehicle was severely damaged in the crash, which occurred in the area of Steeles Ave. and Sixth Line just before 5 a.m.

An investigation by Halton Regional Police resulted in a driving while impaired charge. Nicole Taitt, 30, was released on a promise to appear.
