Halton police have announced the launch of their new free mobile app, which intended to keep members of the public more aware of police matters taking place in their community.

The app, which is available through IOS and Android, provides residents with access to the latest Halton police press releases, crime maps (where residents can see the latest crimes reported and where), frequently asked questions page and more.

Officers said the app also gives members of the community the ability to file a police report directly from their phone.



As technology continues to advance so must our approach to community mobilization and engagement, said Halton Police Deputy Chief Nish Duraiappah in a social media broadcast.

This new app puts the most recent community safety information in the palm of your hand and even allows us to push real-time notifications about missing persons or major road closures directly into your phone.
