

# AHS putting on Fuente Ovejuna

Students at Acton High School have been rehearsing since early February for next week's production of the 15th century Spanish rebellion play Fuente Ovejuna, which has three shows this week.

The play runs on three consecutive nights, from Wednesday to Friday (May 11-13), with the curtain raising at 7 p.m. for each showing.

Play director and drama teacher Jen Ross said the play is set in the Golden Age of Spain in 1476 in the midst of a violent rebellion involving villagers in a small town and a ruthless lord.

Ross noted the cast has had some help with some of the difficult Spanish language pronunciations following the recent arrival of new student Santos Acosta of Argentina. The elaborate set was also designed and built by Mr. Roche's construction class.

Ross noted that viewers are warned about the mature adult content of the play.

There's nothing in it that you haven't seen in Macbeth, she said.
