In the championship series, the Thunder won the first two games and took the decisive contest 6-2 away from home in Courtice.

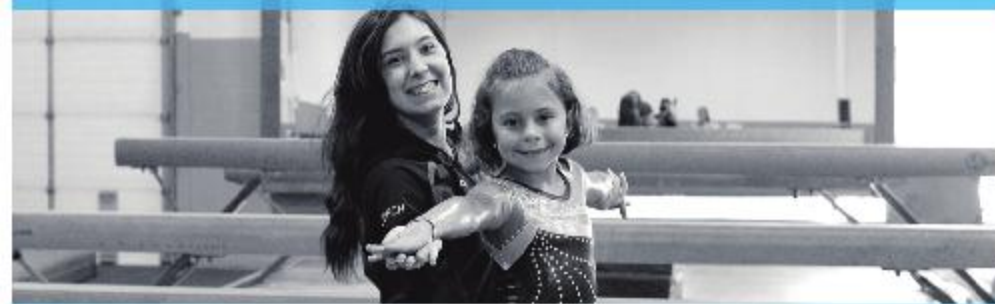
