The 41st-annual Georgetown Highland Games returns to the Fairgrounds this Saturday with a full slate of competitions and activities.

The Honorary Chieftain for this year's event is Dr. Kirsty Duncan, the Minister of Science and MP for Etobicoke North. Master of Ceremonies is Bill Miller.

Event highlights include Highland dancing (8:30 a.m.), heavy athletics (10 a.m.), a piping and drumming competition (8:30 a.m.), massed bands (1 p.m.), children's activities (all day), Fraser Highlanders, military displays, Gathering of the Clans (noon) along with vendors and artisans.

New for 2016 is a free shuttle service to the Fairgrounds from the Gellert Community Centre and the Halton Hills Civic Centre.

The bus will depart the Gellert hourly between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. and the Civic Centre between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

The last shuttle returning from the Games leaves at 8 p.m.

Admission is \$20 for adults, \$10 for seniors and students, with children 12 and under admitted free with a parent.
