Police begin Road Safety Week

Police are on the lookout for what they call the Big 4 Killers.

May 17-23 marks Road Safety Week in Canada and Halton Regional Police says it will be utilizing education and enforcement to drive home the message that certain driving circumstances are dangerous and even potentially deadly.

In support of Canada Road Safety Week, Halton police will adapt a heightened level of presence on roadways, looking for the Big 4 Killers motorists impaired by alcohol or drugs; lack of seatbelt use; and all aspects related to aggressive and distracted driving.

Motorists charged may be subject to licence

suspensions, vehicle seizures and/or fines.

So far in 2016, eight motorists or passengers have died on Halton roadways with seven other people sustaining life-altering injuries.

Police agencies across the country are collaborating on the road safety initiative.

If you observe a vehicle being operated in a manner that places you or anyone else in danger, police say to call 911.
