

## Record-breaking campaign nets Kovacevic top honour

Jade Kovacevic's one and only season with Fanshawe College's women's soccer team left a big impression.

The Halton Hills resident's record-smashing year earned her the school's Female Athlete of the Year Award for 2015-16 recently, among a number of other honours for her 26-goal campaign that broke the previous-best mark in the Ontario Colleges Athletic Association of 20.

An Acton District High School graduate who played for Canada's under-17 and under-20 national teams, midfielder Kovacevic's prolific

season helped the Falcons win the OCAA West Division championship.

The Georgetown Soccer Club product's one-year goal total equaled Fanshawe's career-scoring record and was tops amongst Canadian community colleges as well. She was named OCAA Women's Soccer Player of the Year, an OCAA First-Team All-Star and a CCAA All-Canadian.

Kovacevic graduated from Fanshawe's two-year business marketing program in a year and a half while serving as a coach for the AG London Soccer Club.
