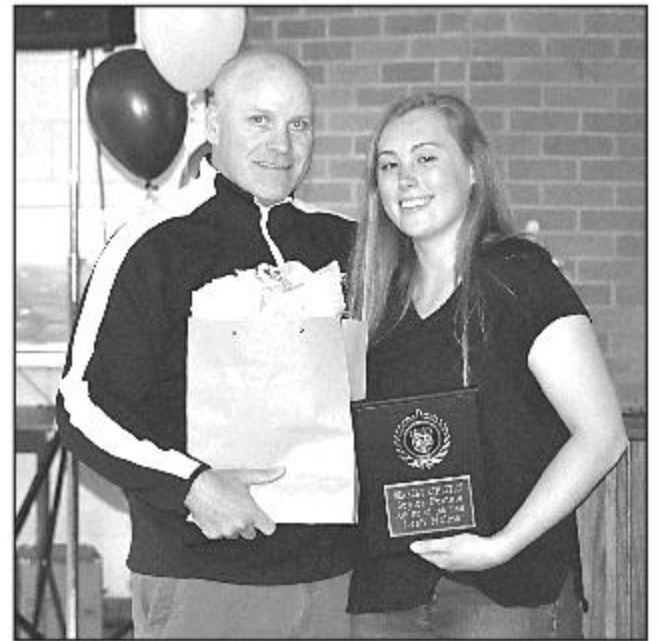
The Male Senior Athlete of the Year was Dan Rhynold, who won MVP for Senior Boys Volleyball
