

Trustees approved agenda items

At the June 15, Board meeting, Trustees approved several action items with system-wide significance impacting both elementary and secondary schools.

The meeting's packed agenda included approval of the 2016-2017 budget, compliant with the province's Public Sector Accountability Board (PSAB) requirements. The 2016-2017 operating budget for the Halton District School Board totals \$712,046,580 while the capital budget totals \$48,938,443.

The Special Education Plan was also approved, an annual requirement of the Ministry of Education. An extensive review of the Special Education Plan was conducted, supported by a review committee made up of members of the Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) and Student Services Department. The proposed amendments to the Special Education Plan provide a clearer and more current description of the special education service delivery model in the Board.

Also approved at the meeting was the Board's Multi-Year Plan. In March 2016, the Board of Trustees and senior administration launched the development of the new plan. The process included an invitation to key stakeholders to review the current plan and determine areas for continuation and/or growth. Trustees considered community input, and reviewed potential gaps and challenges the Board may face in upcoming years, before working with senior staff to refine the Mission Statement, Vision and Values. A series of strategic goals was established and will form the basis for targets and strategies for the annual Operational

The 2016-20 Multi-Year Plan, which includes the Mission, Vision, Values and Goals will lay a foundation for the future of the Board and a legacy that we can all be proud of 'said Kelly Amos, Chair of the Halton District School Board.
