Town will now respond to calls about specific sick wildlife

In the interest of public safety, Halton Hills Canine Control Services are increasing their service and will now respond to calls regarding sick raccoons and skunks on private property. They have always responded to calls on public property. These animals must be accessible to the officers in yard areas and not located in an attic, rooftop or similar inaccessible area. For those animals that are located in inaccessible areas, residents can borrow traps for a \$100 returnable deposit per trap and a \$5 per day fee. Once captured, Canine Control staff will pick up the animal. Halton Hills Canine Control Services can be

reached at 905-877-6235. "We don't want residents to deal with wildlife that may be carrying rabies. Council takes community safety very seriously," said Mayor Rick Bonnette. The Ministry of Natural Resources has also been responding to a recent increase in the number of incidences of raccoons and skunks testing positive for rabies in the Hamilton area. Canine Control Officers will not respond, however to healthy wildlife on private property that may be creating a nuisance. Residents may contact a private pest control company with this problem.
