when you look at this motion, you think, oh, that s out there somewhere else. Well, it is here too. That was very surprising to me, Fogal said.

Councillor David Kentner asked if a copy of this resolution could be sent to Halton Regional Police Chief Stephen J. Tanner, in addition to Laurie Scott, MPP Haliburton-Kawartha Lakes Brock, Ted Arnott, MPP Wellington Halton Hills, Halton Region, Town of Milton, Town of

Oakville and City of Burlington. An amendment was made to meet this request.

Halton Hills Council resolved to support MPP Laurie Scott's private members bill which has been ordered referred to the Standing Committee on Justice Policy.

Saving the Girl Next Door Act, 2016 has three components. First there will be a day of awareness, educating the public on the seriousness and severity of human trafficking in Ontario.

Second, the bill will expand the use

of current law in a way that would have an immediate impact. The bill will make it possible for a protection order to be taken out directly against the trafficker, says Scott's press release. A protection order, similar to a restraining order, would force the perpetrator to stay away from the survivor for a minimum of three years. Failure to comply with the protection order could be met with a penalty of up to \$50,000 or

up to two years of jail, or both.

Third, the bill will increase public awareness of traffickers through the expansion of the definition of sex offence under Christopher s Law (Sex Offender Registry), 2000 to include offences related to the trafficking of persons. With this, anyone would be able to find out if a trafficker is in their community.
