Word on the Street wrapping up

Graffiti art works by students at Georgetown District High School will be up for auction until the end of June in an inaugural fundraiser that has already reached two-thirds of its goal.

The Word on the Street show began June 7 at the Halton Hills Cultural Centre & Library and some of the works produced by about 120 GDHS students, consisting of three Grade 10 art classes and two Grade 9 French classes, are on display on both floors of the library and up for sale until June 27.

To kick off The Word on the Street fundraiser, Georgetown's first-ever free black-tie graffiti art show was held at the library last week and approximately \$1,500 was generated through a silent auction of items donated by local businesses.

Along with sales of the students' art, the initiative has raised more than \$2,000 of the event's \$3,000 goal, said teacher Ronja Philpp.

There's been a lot of energy surrounding the

whole project, said Philpp.

Proceeds will go to two charities, Books With No Bounds and The Drew Hildebrand Teen Benefit Fund.

Philpp said organizers hope to make the fundraiser an annual event, with some possible alterations for next year.
