**Community mourns the loss of Kent Tocher**

A wide circle of family, friends and admirers has been saddened by the passing of Hillsburgh native Kent Tocher, who dedicated himself to lifting people up with his music.

He took his one-man show to weddings, parties, dances, memorial services and sing-a-longs throughout the region, with a special interest in entertaining seniors.

He died on July 4 at Guelph General Hospital after a battle with cancer, in his 70th year.

The funeral was held at Burns Presbyterian Church in Erin on Tuesday.

I'm going to miss him as a friend, said Erin Mayor Al Alls. He was such an enthusiastic guy he had a great joie de vivre.

Known as Keyboard Kent to members of the Young at Heart community singers, for whom he provided accompaniment, he was also proficient on guitar, saxophone and many other instruments.

In his passion for music, he followed in the footsteps of his father John, who was an orchestra leader.

He lived his music, he loved people and he loved Hillsburgh, said neighbour Jackie Turbitt, who knew Mister T for more than 60 years.

He was helpful and funny, and always in a good mood.

He performed for seniors at many retirement homes, for veterans at Sunnybrook Hospital, for the Erin Legion at their annual Remembrance Day dance, at concerts for the Community Services Adult Day Program and at the annual Cemetery Service at the Erin Union Cemetery.

Kent was the husband of Catherine Higgins for 50 years, and father of Holly Tocher of Orangeville, and Chris Tocher and his wife Mary of Ancaster, and grandfather of Eric Rahn of Guelph.

He was the brother of Diane Tocher of Guelph, Paul Tocher of Wallaceburg, and Lee and Barb Tocher of Hillsburgh.
