NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT

IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT AND IN THE MATTER OF the lands in the Town of Halton Hills known municipally as 14249 Tenth Line, Town of Halton Hills and legally described as Part Lots 31 & 32, CON 10 ESQ, Part 1, 20R-11404, Town of Halton Hills, Regional Municipality of Halton, and known as Rolling Hills Farm.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Halton Hills intends to designate the Rolling Hills Farm under Section 29(1), Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest: Rolling Hills Farm's design or physical value is reflected in several aspects of the property. The 1883 house is crafted of stone, likely quarried on this property. The house is unique in the inclusion of an ice house attached to the main building. The large barn from circa 1890 reflects the bank barn construction common to this area and the technical skill of a rack lifter relative to wheat and grain growing farming. The pond, a re-purposed quarry and the dam from 1929 reflect the tourism industry created by stocking the pond with trout. The craftsmanship in the dry



stone wall bordering Tenth Line reflects the Niagara escarpment and farming history. The remnant of the apple orchard reflects the early pioneering history of virtually every farm in Esqueving Township.
