

DRY EYE EXAM: Dr. Joel Schaefer, optometrist and owner of Modern Eyes Optometry, uses meibography, a specialized instrument with infrared light, to image the structure and function of the meibomian glands on Trisha Mackenzie, a patient from Georgetown. The results are used to evaluate meibomian gland dysfunction, the leading cause of dry eye disease, and help formulate a personalized treatment plan.
