## Halton District School Board sets 2016-17 calendar

Trustees of the Halton District School Board have approved the school year calendar proposed dates for 2016-17.

Final approval of the calendar by the Ministry of Education is anticipated later in spring 2016.

The school year calendar is developed with input from the School Year Calendar Committee consisting of representatives from interested and affected groups, including parents.

Where possible, this school year calendar is aligned with the Halton Catholic District School Board calendar, to save resources on school bus transportation, which is shared between the boards.
