Nominations now being accepted for Conservation Halton awards

Laurels offered in five categories

Know an individual or group that's a hero to the environment?

If so, now's the time to recognize them.

Conservation Halton (CH) is now taking nominations for annual awards, which honour people, groups and organizations who strive to protect, preserve or enhance the local environment.

The CH awards include five categories:

- **Citizen Award** — Presented to a citizen who has made a significant effort to improve the natural environment in the Halton Watershed
- **Citizen (Youth) Award** — Presented to a youth who has made a significant effort to improve the natural environment in the Halton Watershed.
- **Community Award** — Presented to a community, organization, institution, municipality, or business that has undertaken a significant conservation action that exemplifies wise conservation.
- **Education Award** — Presented to an individual, group or school that has promoted a better understanding and appreciation of conservation.
- **Stewardship Award** — Presented to a landowner who demonstrates stewardship excellence in protecting the natural environment either on their property, or on public land.

Previous winners include residents, schools, multinational corporations, community environmental groups, gov-

ernment and national non-government organizations.

No effort is too small, and no organization is too big to be nominated.

Candidates for an award can be nominated by any individual or organization. Nominations must be received by midnight on Friday, Oct. 7, and can be submitted online, www.conservation-halton.ca/conservationawards, or by calling 905-336-1158, Ext. 2233.

Completing the nomination form takes only a few minutes.

Try to provide plenty of background information on the nominee and their accomplishments.

This helps the selection committee in making their decision.

Here are some other helpful tips for nominations:

- Nominees will be judged on the quality of their achievement
- Nominations should include sufficient information to give the selection committee a good idea about who the nominee is and the impact of their accomplishment
- Include any additional information you feel will support the nomination, such as photos, testimonial letters and media stories.

Conservation Halton Award recipients will be recognized at an awards night on Tuesday, Nov. 15 at an invitation-only event at the Milton Centre for the Arts.
