

MUNICIPAL, COUNTY & SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS 2014 NOTICE – CANDIDATE NOMINATIONS

NOTICE is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the following municipalities:

Town of Minto, Town of Erin, Township of Centre Wellington, Township of Guelph-Eramosa, Township of Mapleton, Township of Puslinch, Township of Wellington North and the County of Wellington.

Nominations may be made by completing and filing in the office of the Clerk, nominations on the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council and \$100.00 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, certified cheque, money order payable to the municipality, or by an electronic method of payment that the clerk specifies.

A nomination form must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent from January 2, 2014 to September 11, 2014 between 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on September 12, 2014 (Nomination Day) between 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m..

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only on Wednesday, September 17, 2014 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting places will be opened on the dates stated below for the purpose of voting.


