They offer these tips, especially if you're away from your home:


- Leave your travel schedule and phone number with a trusted neighbour or relative so that you may be contacted if necessary


Change your clock and smoke alarm batteries

On Sunday March 9, the clocks spring ahead one hour in time, and this is also a great time to test your smoke alarms and change their batteries.

Halton Hills Fire Chief Brent Marshall strongly recommends changing your smoke alarm batteries and then testing the alarm to ensure it will function. Aside from pushing the test button to sound the alarm, another easy way to test it, is to hold a lit incense stick 10 - 12" below the alarm and allow the smoke to drift into the device causing it to sound.

Once the alarm sounds, fan the smoke away and give the de-

vice a quick vacuuming to ensure it is free of dust which can affect the performance of the smoke alarm.

The fire service suggests that smoke alarms between seven-and-10 years old, are candidates for replacement. Manufacturers' specifications may also include an expiry date, which may be stamped on the device; however, generally speaking, the life span of a smoke alarm is 10 years.


