# Streets for all ages

Increased cost to make streets pedestrian and cyclist friendly is one councillor's 'fear'

The Town will continue "exploring opportunities" to build so-called Complete Streets where it is reasonable, safe and affordable. Complete Streets are those planned, designed, operated and maintained to be safe for all users and abilities, including pedestrians, and cyclists and private and commercial vehicles.

At a recent general committee meeting, Regional/Acton Councillor Clark Somerville sought assurances from staff about how the Complete Streets would roll out, and dovetail with existing Town plans, like the Cyc-

Master Plans. He has a particular concern with Five Side Road where the cost increase would be "huge" to buy necessary property. "That's my fear..." Somerville said.

Town Engineer John Kwast said in the past two years they've successfully integrated Complete Streets principles into capital projects, and they aren't recommending a policy at this time, but will continue exploring integration.

Kwast said policy or not, the decision to implement any Complete Streets features would be if it is in the
