

Halton Hills Inuit Outreach collecting donations for winter shipment

The Inuit Outreach Project is reaching out to the Halton Hills community and beyond as they prepare for the semi-annual donation drive for the Nunavut and Nunavik communities. The Winter Donation Drive was launched following Labour Day. Donations can be dropped off each Wednesday from 10 a.m.-12 p.m. or 7-8:30 p.m. at St. Paul's Anglican Church, 16 Adamson St., South, Norval at the hall (side door). Last day for donations is Nov. 16.

Inuit Outreach is a not-for-profit, registered Ontario charity. They are wholly supported by three local Anglican Churches, St. John's (Stewarttown) St. Stephen's (Hornby) and St. Paul's (Norval).

St. Paul's provides the facility for housing the donations where they manage the logistics. Volunteers are always welcome including high school students.

The wish list of essential items that are desperately needed to help offset the high cost of living are:

- new or nearly new clothing for babies and children;
- diapers and wipes;
- baby toiletries;
- linens: blankets, bed sheets, towels;
- knitting yarn, sewing threads and needles;
- fabric including leather, for clothing construction;
- sewing machines, machine needles, including needles for leather;
- toiletries including soaps, toothbrushes and toothpaste, personal hygiene products for women;
- due to health regulations they only accept new underwear, socks, boots and shoes;
- there are no dry cleaners in the northern communities they support, so no materials that need special cleaning;
- donations should be new or almost new and in current fashion.

They ask that you presort your items and label them according to the wish list.
