## No Frills foundations

Construction began yesterday (Wednesday) on the No Frills supermarket in Acton East, on target for a mid-October opening, according to Craft Development Corporation boss Carmine Nigro who said they received temporary

permits to begin foundation and footing work earlier this week.

"We are still working with the Town on a few very minor issues and hope to have our Building Permit within two weeks," Nigro said on Tuesday, adding the temporary permit allows them to not hold up the development process while dealing with issues including architectural features.

"The Town wanted more masonry and architectural features - not just a Plane Jane metal façade, so we are working on that," he said, adding things have moved smoothly since they came to agreement with neighbours concerning layout of the building, parking and landscaping.

The Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) approved the supermarket plans - Sobeys and adjacent neighbours dropped their objections - and rezoned the property at 388 Queen St. E. to Corridor commercial from medium density, which would have allowed a multi-story apartment.
