

OPP REPORT

Drug Seizure

On November 15, at approximately 3:07 p.m. members of the Wellington County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) investigated the driver of a Nissan Al-

tima for a Highway Traffic Act violation Wellington Road 32 near Wellington Road 124 in Guelph-Eramosa Township.

Police detected the strong odour of burnt

marihuana emanating from inside the motor vehicle and observed a small quantity of marihuana as well. Police placed the driver under arrest and a search was conducted resulting in Oxycodone and Percocet being seized.

A 21 year old Cambridge man has been charged with Possession of Marihuana

Under 30 Grams and Possession of Schedule 1 Substance (Other Drugs) contrary to the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act. He is scheduled to appear in Guelph Criminal Court on December 16, to answer to the charges.

Drinking and Driving
On November 21, at approximately 3:09 a.m.,

Wellington County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) officers received a traffic complaint about a 2000 Jeep. Police located the vehicle on Wellington Road 22 near 5th Line, Guelph-Eramosa Township and spoke with the driver. Officers believed him to be under the influence of alcohol. He was

arrested and transported to a local OPP Operations Centre for testing.

A 22 year old of Guelph-Eramosa Township man has been charged with Impaired Driving and Over 80 contrary to the Criminal Code. He is scheduled to appear in Guelph Criminal Court on December 12, to answer to the charges.
