a night to maintain the rink. So, if your rink has seven volunteers, that would be one hour per week per volunteer.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Guelph/Eramosa is inviting applications of interest from persons who wish to represent the Township of Guelph/Eramosa in the following legislated positions for the upcoming four year term, from December 1, 2014 to November 30, 2018.

#### FENCE VIEWER

3 appointments – Meetings as required.

The Line Fences Act provides a procedure, administered by the local municipality, for resolving fencing disputes between neighbouring land-owners. Disputes are resolved by local fence viewers, appointed by Council, who make an award apportioning responsibility for the fence between two owners.

Remuneration (payment) for this position is \$90.00 per call and \$0.54 per kilometer for mileage.

#### PROPERTY STANDARDS COMMITTEE

3 appointments – Meetings as required.

The Township of Guelph/Eramosa has set standards for the maintenance and occupancy of properties within its boundaries. The function of this committee is to hear appeals, filed by owners or occupants of property within the Township of Guelph/Eramosa, after they have been served with an order to maintain their property according to the standards prescribed by Property Standards By-law 10/2009.

Remuneration (payment) for this position is \$75.00 per meeting.

#### COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT

3 appointments - Meeting twice a month in the evening, pending applications. The Committee of Adjustment is a quasi-judicial body and its main function is to consider Minor Variance applications under the provisions of the Planning Act.

Remuneration (payment) for this position is \$75.00 per meeting.
