Acton firm donates \$15,000 to arena project

Money in memory of hockey-loving friend

Acton Auto Tech has donated \$15,000 to the Town's Play at Home Stay at Home arena fundraising campaign in honour of Trefor Gardener, a former apprentice/employee/coowner who succumbed to cancer last year.

"He was a hockey nut, and we wanted to do something for Acton," said Acton Auto Tech owner Floyd Foster, adding that he and son Norm Foster made the decision to make the donation de-

The Fosters' donation will help pay for one of three new dressing rooms at Acton arena. The \$10.5-milion expansion includes a second NHLsize ice pad, six additional dressing rooms, two more referee rooms, and additional seating. The new ice pad will be ready for the start of the 2015 sea-
