Halton District School Board had another outstanding school year

We were successful as a board, as a staff and our students also had a stellar year. First to the kids; all our EQAO scores were above the provincial average as a board, our numeracy results were up by 2 per cent and number of students performing at Level 4 rose by 2 per cent. Phenomenal! Our Kids Halton report stated that our students reported a 5 per cent increase in school engagement this year. We increased the number of e- learning courses available and also increased our blended learning opportunities (3300 students and 532 teachers).

Our 2013/14 budget has been approved and totals \$632,518,641, while the capital budget totals \$59,805,368. This budget reflects an on-going commitment to student achievement and continprograms and services for every student. Recognizing the three goal areas of the Halton District School Board's Multi-Year Plan --Students, Staff, and System -- the budget reflects the needs of a growing school



board through investment in school teaching staff, school support staff and administrative staff. It includes additional Children and Youth workers in our schools to help address mental health needs of our students.

ual improvement of Board its Safe Schools policy and is proud to say our reported incidences of bullying have decreased and kids report feeling safer at school. Watch for additional mental health and bullying reduction strategies to be announced in the fall. We also are working at keeping our kids safe at school and have added or will be adding additional surveillance cameras and door security systems to all schools.

As the year draws to a close we want to congratulate all those students who are transitioning whether it be to a new school or onto work/college/university. We are proud of your achievements and hope that you are proud to say you are an HDSB student.


