**Children and youth initiatives benefit from one-year grants**

As part of the 2013 allocation for the Halton Region Community Investment Fund, Regional Council approved 16 one-year grants for non-profit programs and projects in Halton that provide community health and social service programs in the community.

An additional eight programs will receive funding for the second year of a multi-year grant approved in 2012. The total amount awarded for one-year and multi-year funding in 2013 is \$746,594.
