How to implement blueprint for prosperity

A major milestone in Town efforts to achieve a higher quality of life – cultural vibrancy, economic prosperity, environmental health and social well-being – has been hit with Council approval of a plan to implement Imagine Halton Hills, the Integrated Community Sustainability Strategy to seep sustainability into the Town's day-to-day operations.

The Action Plan consists of 18 priority actions to be implemented over the next two years. The actions address the need for an effective governance model, various implementation tools and progress reporting.

Highlights include the establishment of a "Community Sustainability Investment Fund", preparation of an action inventory of all existing and proposed actions, completion of a Corporate Sustainability Audit, and a bi-annual "State of Sustainability Report".

Halton Hills Mayor Rick Bonnette said the Imagine Halton Hills strategy is based on widespread community input, and is unique because it addresses economic prosperity, cultural vibrancy, environmental health and social well-being. "We now have a practical action plan in place that will ensure the strategy's implementation. In turn, this will lead to a better quality of life for us all. Implementation will be our joint responsibility, so, I encourage everyone to get involved," Bonnette said.

Imagine Halton Hills is a community-based strategy that requires the community's active participation to help implement the strategy. Anyone interested is encouraged to contact the Office of Sustainability located in the Planning, Development and Sustainability Department.
