# Halton Police kick off return to school safety campaign

On Monday, the Halton Regional Police Service will kick off its annual traffic safety initiative; "Project Safe Start", the eighth year police will conduct this campaign which centres on education, awareness and high-visibility enforcement of traffic laws in and around school zones. The campaign is run in conjunction within the first two weeks that Halton school children return to classes and runs until September 13.

Halton police recognize this concern and will engage in various campaigns throughout the year to educate the motoring public on, and enforcing the Highway Traffic Act and other traffic related legislation.






