
#### DEATH

Mac passed away in the company

of his family at the Georgetown Hospital on Monday, September 16, 2013. He is survived by Joyce, his wife of 49 years and will be missed by his daughters Dianne Utter and Marie Boivin (Paul) and his grandchildren: Leslee Utter, Amy Karlin (Michael), Travis and Jennifer Boivin. Mac was predeceased by his parents, John (1991) and Beatrice Sprowl (1992) and his brother Calvin (1995). Mac was born on his parents' Third Line farm and attended Bannockburn School and Acton Continuation School. He joined the Acton Junior Farmers in 1947 and was the President in 1951, Halton Junior Farmers in 1952 and was President of the Acton Fair in 1953. Mac was awarded a Lord Nuffield Scholarship to Great Britain in 1954. He was President of the Halton Federation of Agriculture and subsequently sat on their Board of Governors for five years. He was a Member of the Esquesing Area School Board for 5 years and the Rotary Club of Acton for more than 50 years. In politics he was a staunch Conservative. Mac retired as the longest serving Sheriff of the Halton Region.
