Missing teen found safe

Tired and apparently lost, 14-year-old Cody Peller of Guelph/Eramosa Township was found in good health by a citizen at 10:33 on Wednesday morning, more than 38 hours since his family reported him missing at 8 p.m. on Monday.

Air and land searches for the slight, bespeckled teen were conducted around the clock, and on Tuesday, OPP asked the public not to help in the search as it was 'creating issues" for police and the canine unit. At the time, OPP said they had 'concerns" for the 5'6",

90-pound teen because of his age.

OPP said a citizen "came upon" Peller, not at his home but in Guelph/Eramosa Township, and was concerned he seemed tired and lost and called police.

"We are extremely pleased with the outcome and would like to remind people if you see something that seems out of the ordinary of suspicious - say something. You never know where it may lead," said Wellington OPP Detachment Commander Scott Lawson in a press release issued Wednesday.



Prevent kitchen

During Fire Prevention Week October 6-12, Halton Hills joins forces with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and the Ontario Office of the Fire Marshal reminding local residents to "Prevent Kitchen Fires & Get Cooking with Fire Safety."

During this year's fire safety campaign, fire departments will spread the word about the dangers of kitchen fires; most which result from unattended cooking, as well as educating local residents on how to prevent kitchen fires from starting.

According to the latest NFPA research, cooking is the leading cause of home fires. Two-of-five home fires begin in the kitchen; more than any other place in the home. Cooking fires are also the leading cause of home fire-related injuries.

"Often when we're called to a fire that started in the kitchen, the residents tell us that they only left the kitchen for a few minutes," said Chief Brent Marshall. "Sadly, that's all it takes for a dangerous fire to start. We hope that Fire Prevention Week will help us reach folks in the community before they've suffered a damaging lesson."

Halton Hills Mayor Rick Bonnette said fire is a dangerous opponent which can quickly endanger lives and property, but there are fire safety tips to ensure to ensure safety in the kitchen.

Stay in the kitchen when you are frying, grilling, broiling, or boiling food. If you must leave the room, even for a short period of time, turn off the stove. When you are simmering, baking, or roasting food, check it regularly, stay in the home, and use a timer to remind you. If you have young children, use the stove's back burners whenever possible. Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the stove. When you cook, wear clothing with tight-fitting sleeves. Keep potholders, oven mitts, wooden utensils, paper and plastic bags, towels, and anything else that can burn, away from your stovetop. Clean up food and grease from burners and stovetops.

Fire Prevention Week is actively supported by fire departments across the country. Fire Prevention Week is the longest running public health and safety observance on record.
