One-lane woes

Get used to the long, frustrating traffic delays along Queen Street - it will be one-lane traffic for the next two months as the Region replaces the aging and leaking water and wastewater pipes in a \$4.8-million project that included upgrading services in the Glenlea subdivision.

Brenda Kingsmill, Halton's Design Supervisor for Waste Water Services, said on Friday the crew began digging a new 450-metre watermain trench on the south

side of the road from Eastern Avenue, just west of Hillcrest to Churchill Road. The pre-1950 water pipe runs along the north side of the road, and the sanitary sewer, installed in 1951, runs down the middle. The new sanitary sewer will run from Wellington Road to Churchill Boulevard.

Kingsmill said the final part of the project, slated for competition in November, will replace the water and wastewater pipes on Meadvale Road.




