

# They're coming! School begins Tuesday for public board students

It is a race against time at Robert Little School where crews are working long hours to complete construction of three new early learning rooms for Junior and Senior Kindergarten.

Robert Little joins a growing list of Halton schools to introduce the Full Day Early Learning Kindergarten (FDELK) program, which features play-based learning with teachers and Early Childhood Educators acting as

guides in the class.

The Halton District School Board will spend \$13-million to implement Full Day Early Learning in 19 schools this September. The price tag to prepare Robert Little is \$550,000, plus 15 per cent for permits, fees, furniture and equipment.

If all three classes are not ready next week, the two classes that will be available will be used, and the third class will be held temporarily in the

music room. While the full-time Senior Kindergarten classes begin with the rest of the grades on Tuesday, the Junior Kindergarten and all new SK and JK students will have several staggered visits this week and begin full time next week. At press time, there were approximately 75 JK/SK students registered at Robert Little, and more are expected to register right up to the first day of class.
