

Motorists eager for Wallace Street to re-open

Downtown Acton's best bypass, Wallace Street, may re-open tomorrow (Friday), helping to ease the construction caused bottlenecks on Queen

Street, and adjacent roads like Church Street, Bower Avenue and Peel Street.

"I'm hoping (it's open) Friday, but I have to get all of the traffic signs up,

and all of the line marking done," said project manager Kevin Chalmers on Tuesday. He said it's up to the contractor to get the line marking scheduled,

and he was waiting to hear if that had been done.

"If the work isn't completed until the weekend, then we would open on Monday, and it may not

be Monday, it may be next Friday," Chalmers said.

The \$993,000 reconstruction project includes the realignment of Wal-


lace Street at McDonald Boulevard, straightening of a dangerous curve, new curbs, and a three-metre wide asphalt sidewalk/bike path.
