Sustainability

Town Needs Input

An exciting path is being taken by the Town of Halton Hills and its residents towards a more sustainable future, with a great quality of life for all. A blueprint for achieving this future will be outlined in the Community Sustainability Strategy.

Mayor Rick Bonnette said The Community Sustainability Strategy is a very unique and exciting project. "It is taking a long-term view to imagine a more sustainable future for Halton Hills and to develop a blueprint for how we can get there. Our residents' input is key to making this a Strategy that is truly based on community input," he said.

To date, significant progress has been made in working towards the Strategy.
