Police/Fire Report

Do you know these men?

Halton police have released composite sketches of two men who are "persons of interest" in the September 19 armed robbery of the Hornby Pump Gas Bar that left a male employee suffering serious knife wounds.

Police said at 8:30 p.m., two males entered the gas bar in an older model, white, off-white or light grey Tempo or Mercury Topaz. An armed male entered the kiosk and demanded cash. In the struggle, the employee suffered severe lacerations and wounds from what police called an "edged weapon." His condition was upgraded on Friday to serious, but stable.

Police would like to speak with both males. One is white, 25 to 30, six-feet with a medium, somewhat muscular build,

and black or dark short hair. The second man is white, 40 to 45 years old, six-feet, with salt and pepper, collar-length hair.
