Residents band together to help family after crash

After a head-on crash last year sent a local car crash, Kelowna residents banded together to show how there is strength in numbers.

Last week, a local car crash struck the Kelowna community as four people lost their lives. The tragedy left widows Billi Ko-

ssic wondering what can we do to help?

I just had this desire to want to do something, Koosis said. It struck like this together so it clearly to me thought what can we do?

Like any good neighbor, Koosis brought a hot meal, baked off, over to the family. Then, as she spent her time, a way of showing her love to the widow.

Through new information, Koosis was able to organize a way for local people to donate meals to the family. The drive ran from Oct. 11 all the way until Nov. 16 where a number of days have already been filled with meals, such as homemade turkey soup and chicken, along with garlic bread and fresh vegetables.

We have had an amazing response, Koosis said. People

are coming to my house with a card and a meal. Some have brought gift cards and donations.

On the website, Koosis listed her home address for people to drop the meals off to. Every day, at about 3 or 3:30 p.m., Koosis drives by the family's home and gives them the total of the day. So far, not a single day has been missed.
