Updates given regarding Georgetown, Acton GO service

When Nick Benedetto welcomed representatives from communities along the Metro Hill corridor at an information meeting last week.

Representative from Metro Hill, which manages the GO train and bus services, shared an update on where the planning of the extension of service currently sits. Community consultation and environmental assessment (EA) are important steps that will be completed over the next few years. Construction of a light rail bus, announced by the Province in June, is not expected to begin for several years, depending on the outcomes of the consultation and EA.

All day (on-way) GO service for Georgetown and Acton is very important, however as financing at the moment can be, we must explore the process and steps that are required before this can be a reality, said Metro Hill. In the meantime, I did push for modifications to existing GO service that could potentially be an immediate relief to existing schedules. Metro Hill did commit to reviewing the request.

The meeting was also attended by representatives from communities along the Metro Hill corridor (participating entities including Nepean, Guelph Express and Glenora).
