## Smoke alarm disposal program offered to residents

The recent Fire Prevention Week theme was Don't Wait, Check the Date of your smoke alarms.

Smoke alarms don t last forever and to maintain protection of your family residents should check the expiry date on the back of the devices to ensure they don t expire. If you haven t yet checked your smoke alarms it s never too late.

We are trying to encourage everyone to check the date of their existing smoke alarms, and replace if older than ten years, said Fire Chief, John deHooge.

For those who determine that they need to replace their smoke alarms, the Halton Hills Fire Department will now accept expired smoke alarms for disposal at the Acton station at 21 Churchill Rd. and the Headquarters station at 14007 10 Sideroad in Georgetown between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Fire department staff have been reminding the citizens of our community for several years the importance of having working smoke alarms in their residence.

This is another step you can take to ensure your family s safety in the event of a fire, reminds Mayor Rick Bonnette.
