Upon spotting the vehicle again, the victim ran towards it before the suspects

sped off, turning south onto Mountainview Rd. S. The men were able to obtain a description of the driver, a white male wearing a red baseball cap.

The complainants spoke with the responding officer, who noted she saw a welt on the man's neck. Shortly after, the officer spotted the suspect vehicle

headed northbound on Mountainview Rd. S. and conducted a traffic stop.

After speaking with the driver, the officer described detecting a strong odour of marijuana and an egg was splattered on the hood of the SUV.

Two Georgetown males and two Acton female occupants of the vehicle were placed under arrest for two counts of as-

sault and possession of a controlled substance.

The females were later issued a Youth Criminal Justice Act warning and released to their parents, while the males attended 11 Division in Georgetown and released by means of diversion to their parents.

The victim's daughter told The

Independent & Free Press her mother was struck by an egg while out for a walk in the same area of Georgetown South in July and said that both parents have been traumatized as a result.
