

# Early St. fire causes \$65K in damages

Halton Hills firefighters responded to the report of a possible structure fire on Early St. in Georgetown South last Thursday (Nov. 10) just before 10 p.m.

Fire staff arrived on scene to smoke and flames visible from the rear deck.

They quickly knocked down the fire and entered the basement of the structure to check for smoke and any fire in the home.

Staff found the fire had extended into the basement ceiling, which was quickly exposed and extinguished.

Damage to the outside deck, basement and contents is estimated at \$65,000.

The fire investigation into the incident found that the fire originated in the area of the deck but a cause remains undetermined.

### FAULTY SMOKE ALARM

On Nov. 7 firefighters responded to a public assist for a smoke alarm beeping on Charles St.

On scene fire staff determined that a smoke alarm with a low battery was mak-

ing the alarm beep intermittently.

Fire staff replaced the battery in the malfunctioning alarm as well as the two others in the residence.

### TWO-VEHICLE CRASH

At 1:11 p.m. Nov. 7 firefighters responded to a two-vehicle motor vehicle collision in the area of Mountainview and Sargent Rds.

Halton Regional Police and ambulance were on scene upon arrival.

Fire staff applied absorbent to leaking fluids and cleared the scene.

### TRUCK IN DITCH

Firefighters responded to the report of a gravel truck that had rolled over into a ditch in the area of Trafalgar and Hornby Rds. last Friday at about 2:30 p.m.

Once on scene, crews discovered a single gravel truck, with trailer, that had left the roadway and was lying on its side in the ditch.

The driver was able to get out of the vehicle himself prior to emergency services arrival and was uninjured.
