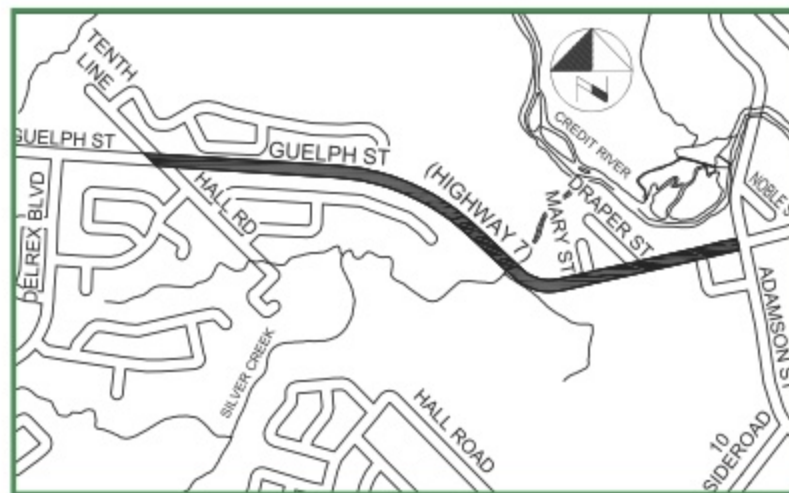

Halton Region is proposing to install a new 300 mm watermain on Guelph Street from the Norval Standpipe to Adamson Street in the Town of Halton Hills (Norval). The project is part of a larger watermain replacement program in the area. The project will involve excavating and installing a new watermain along Guelph Street from Delrex Blvd to Adamson Street. The project is estimated to cost \$1.5 million. The project will be completed by the end of 2017. The project will be funded by the Town of Halton Hills and the Province of Ontario.
