## Georgetown Market Place donates \$2,500 to Treasures for Teens

Since the year 2000, Halton Regional Police have teamed up with the Salvation Army to make Christmas wishes come true for hundreds of kids in the region with the Toys for Tots program.

The campaign collected approximately \$345,000 in gifts and cash donations that were distributed to those in need last year, yet there's a segment of the population that seems to be forgotten about at this time of year, said Const. Maureen Andrew of the Halton Regional Police's One District Community Mobilization Bureau.

That's why Toys for Tots has an offshoot program called Treasures for Teens, intended to sup-

port youths in the 10-18 age group who for whatever reason, wouldn't otherwise receive gifts at Christmas.

Andrew said she's already received 45 wish lists of gifts from disadvantaged teens in this area and the campaign is only a week old.

Members of the public are invited to donate cash, Canadian Tire money and/or new, unwrapped toys at any Canadian Tire location or any police station in Halton Region until Dec. 18.

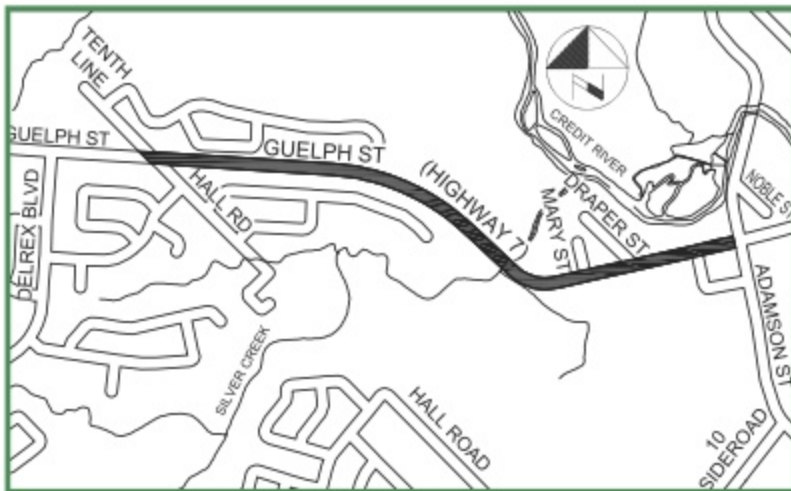
