- Spruce, fir, pine, spruce
- Pruned trees (up to 25 L)
- Christmas trees (up to 25 L)
- Branches (up to 7.5 cm diameter)
- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Mulch
- Compost
- Potting soil
- Lawn fertilizer
- Planters
- Flower markers
- Plant tags



- ✓ Permitted:**
  - Leaves
  - Decorative cornstalks
  - Potting soil
  - Fallen fruit from trees
- ✗ Not Permitted:**
  - Stumps (over 7.5 cm diameter)
  - Limbs
  - Plastic flower/plant pots
  - Flower/plant markers and tags
