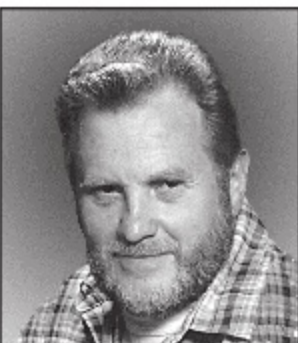


CHISHOLM: John Eric
