Alleged drunk driver wanted on charge of failing to appear in court

Halton Police are searching for 29-year-old Sacha Dzugalo of Brampton.

It is alleged that in May of 2016, Dzugalo was operating a motor vehicle in Burlington when she was involved in a collision by striking a light pole.

Dzugalo was arrested and charged by police with impaired driving and possession of a controlled substance and was later charged with driving with more than 80 mgs of alcohol in her blood.

Dzugalo has since failed to appear for her court dates and her whereabouts are unknown at this time, police say.

She is now also wanted on a charge of failing to appear in court.

Dzugalo is described as 5-foot-2, 133 lbs with brown hair and brown eyes. She has a tattoo of a star on her right forearm and a star on her left wrist.

Dzugalo is known to frequent Burlington, Hamilton, Brampton, Mississauga and the surrounding areas.
