

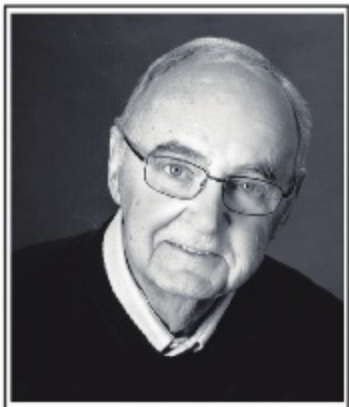


McEACHERN (Brady), Mureen Mary
