have warm, safe places to go to escape from the cold when an alert is issued," says Mayor Rick Bonnette. "We have been in touch with community service providers to inform them of the Town's Warming Centres as they deal first-hand with the people who may be most vulnerable.

Extreme Cold Weather Alerts are issued by the Halton Region Health Department when temperatures are expected to fall below -15 degrees Celsius (without wind-chill), or when weather conditions are severe enough to warrant alerting the community to the risks involved with prolonged exposure.

Anyone can be affected by extreme cold-related weather conditions, depending on length of time of exposure to cold and exertion levels.

During extreme cold, residents are encouraged to call or visit friends and neighbours who may be at risk and keep pets inside. You can avoid cold-related injuries by dressing appropriately and covering exposed skin.

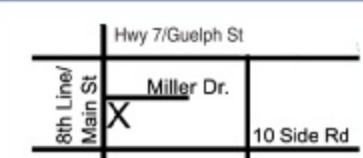
