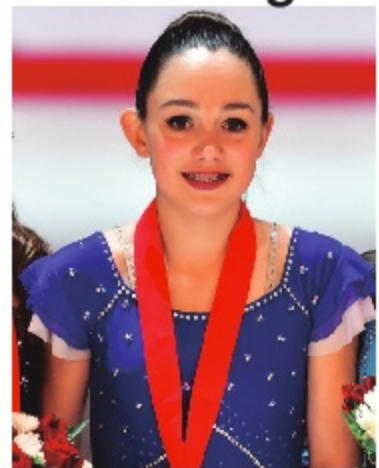


## Carle reigns supreme at nationals



Catherine Carle's gold rush is now complete. Triumphant at every turn this season, the Milton Skating Club standout delivered a record-breaking victory at the national championships Tuesday afternoon in Ottawa.

Her 91.85-point free program a near-flawless routine set to Anastasia's Once Upon A December gave her an overall score of 133.73.

That not only won her the national title in commanding fashion, but eclipsed the Canadian standard (131.22) she set a few weeks earlier at the Skate Canada Challenge in Pierrefonds, Quebec.

The 13-year-old Georgetown resident beat out B.C.'s Emma Bulawka by 11 points for the gold.
