Halton Regional Police are investigating a fatal single motor vehicle collision that occurred Monday morning on Winston Churchill Blvd. in Halton Hills.

At approximately 8:30 a.m., a southbound pickup truck left the roadway and entered the west ditch in the area of 27 Sideroad, coming to rest just before a

The driver, identified as a 72-year-old Terra Cotta resident, was transported to Georgetown Hospital, where he was pronounced deceased.

Neither speed, alcohol, road nor weather conditions are believed to be contributing factors, police said.

The Collision Reconstruction Unit took over investigation of the incident and Winston Churchill Blvd. was closed for about five hours.


